An attractive ruby hued red. Rich and velvety with bags of ripe plums, prune and raisined fruit, vanilla and spice. Goes well with tomato dishes which are notoriously difficult to match with wine.	
La Coteaux, Cotes du Rhone Villages, Boutinot 2006 (France)	£16.90
Smooth ruby red with baked red and blackberry fruits laced with pepper and spice.	
Nieto Reserva Malbec 2006 (Argentina)	£18.95
Powerful red, with flavours of plum, figs and dried fruits, with a smoky vanilla character. International Wine Challenge silver medal 2008.	
Tabali Special Reserve Pinot Noir 2006 (Chile)	£19.50
From Chile's the coolest vineyard area Limari Valley, pureed red berry fruits and spiced. Great with lamb dishes. Silver, (best in class), International Wine & Spirits Competition 2008	
Norfolk Rise Shiraz 2006 (Australia)	£21.50
Just great Shiraz displaying blackcurrant & cherry fruit dusted with clove, aniseed, chocolate and pepper.	
Monte Real Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Riojanas 2002 (Spain)	£23.50
